



PRESENTERS INFORMATION

Who can present Tar Wars?

Tar Wars can be presented by family physicians, residents, medical students, school nurses, health care professionals, educators, nurses, physician assistants, dental hygienists and physical fitness teachers.

What do I need and how much time will it take?

Tar Wars program can be presented in a 45 to 60 minute session, and preparation time is minimal. The program curriculum is free and provides a scripted lesson plan that walks you through all aspects of the presentation.

Responsibilities of a Tar Wars Presenter:

1. State Coordinators will match you with a school requesting the program. You will contact school/teacher to schedule presentation. Classroom size should be limited to 30 students if possible.
2. Presentations must be presented between September 1, 2011 and March 1, 2012.
3. Review curriculum. Other resource material can be found at www.tarwars.org
4. Give presentation! If you cannot give presentation when scheduled please contact school.
5. Don't forget to give the students **POSTER RULES & DEADLINES**. Examples of past artwork can be viewed on www.tarwars.org. *Note: West Virginia won First Place in 2008 and has placed several times in past contests.*
